General Conditions

Enrolment

* Formal enrolment will be carried out by email.

* For the placing of a booking deposit we require the following information: name of the young person; date of birth; name of parent or guardian; DNI (for Spanish bookings); contact details including address, phone number and email; as well as any other information which you feel might be important.

- The booking deposit shall be 30% of the total cost of the programme and must be lodged within seven days of formal enrolment. It is important that the young person's name and the programme they are to attend (i.e. July or August) should be noted on this lodgement. Where the booking deposit has not been paid within seven days of notice of enrolment we reserve the right to cancel the enrolment.

Payment of the balance due must take place at least 40 days before the start of the programme to be attended.

Cancellation Fees

- Cancellation must be done in writing, preferably by email.
- With respect to the booking deposit : if the cancellation occurs within seven days of the payment being made, then the deposit will be returned in its entirety. After this time the booking deposit will be forfeited unless certified evidence justifying the cancellation is presented (e.g. medical certificate).
- With regard to refund of the second payment made, the following conditions will apply: if cancellation is notified at least forty days before commencement of the summer season, 100% of this payment will be refunded; if at least thirty days before commencement of the summer season then 75% of this payment will be refunded; if at least twenty days before commencement of the summer season then 50% will be refunded; if at least ten days before commencement of the summer season then 10% will be refunded. If notification of cancellation is received less than ten days from commencement of the summer season then no money will be refunded. For these purposes the summer season will be understood as commencing on the first day of the July programme.

Programme Rules

- Participants must show due respect to the other participants, to group leaders and the co-ordinators. The times established for eating and sleeping must also be respected, as well as all material, buildings and installations.
- Consumption of tobacco and alcohol as well as all illegal drugs is prohibited, as well as the possession of knives and other sharp objects and all violent behaviour.

Where these rules are infringed the organisers will take appropriate action to ensure the smooth functioning of the programme, including possible expulsion of the participant.
